The Governors are committed to supporting the school in its endeavours and to ensuring that the following are achieved in the light of its Mission Statement "Christ at the Centre of Living and Learning":	The Governors consider that the following criteria are evidence of successful implementation of each of the policy statements:
1. to ensure that staff are trained and supported in the management of behaviour	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a proactive and effective training programme focused on learning, with reward strategies, is in place • all staff are aware of the Positive Handling Procedure
2. to ensure that governors and the school observe their statutory obligation with regards to discipline	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • there is appropriate action to minimise and, where necessary, to respond to disciplinary situations
3. there is an educative and disciplinary procedure on Drugs and other illegal substances	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a regular programme of Drugs education is in place for students, parents and staff • there are known disciplinary procedures when drugs and other illegal substances are found in students' possession
4. to ensure that parents are involved in the management of their child's behaviour as a student, and to this end governors strongly encourage families to discuss, sign and adhere to the whole school agreement (agreement of conduct)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • all families are invited to sign the "home school agreement" • all signatories are encouraged to adhere to this agreement • all students adhere to the school's anti-bullying procedures • all students are aware of possible sanctions if their behaviour does not meet expected standards
5. to ensure the active involvement of the students in the establishment and maintenance of good student behaviour	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the school encourages personal good behaviour • students are consulted in establishing standards • all students are given responsibility to work with the staff to maintain good order
6. to ensure that students adhere to the school's requirements for attendance and punctuality, and to the dress code	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • students attend school punctually and on every school day • parents ensure their children's attendance • parents support the school's dress code • students abide by the school's dress code
